This notice satisfies a procedural requirement for activities to be undertaken by the Cherokee Nation.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Marble City Community Building Project: The project consists of demolition of 5 structures, a gymnasium (Circa 1950s), a pantry building (Circa 1980s), a metal building (Circa 2015), an office building (Circa 2000s), and a well house (Circa 1950s). The project also includes new construction of a community/cultural building. The project will include water and sanitary sewer services connection &/or installation, no other activities will occur on site. The proposed project site is located on the Southwest corner of Main St and Seminole Ave in Marble City, OK. The legal description is as follows: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 25 Township 13 North, Range 23 East, Sequoyah County, Oklahoma. This project will cost approximately \$5,000,000 and will not involve activities other than those listed above.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The Cherokee Nation has determined this project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required.
