Vice-Chair, Pamela Sellers read the decision in the Mayes case in which the Order affirmed the decision of the Cherokee Nation Election Commission. A motion was made by Randy Campbell and seconded by Rick Doherty to deem Chuck Hoskin, Jr., Bryan Warner and Deb Proctor as eligible candidates in the 2019 General Election. Court Case No. Sc-2019-02 Challenge to Eligibility of Rhonda Brown Fleming, Candidate for Chief for the 2019 General Election:

Vice- Chair, Pamela Sellers read the decision on the Challenge of Eligibility of Rhonda Brown Fleming in which the Order read that the appeal be and is hereby dismissed. The Court further found that the Cherokee Nation Election Commission determined Brown-Fleming not eligible as a candidate for Chief because she does not comply with the constitutional residency requirements for the office of Principal Chief. A motion was made Randy Campbell and seconded by Rick Doherty to deem Rhonda Brown Fleming ineligible as a candidate for the office of Chief in the 2019 General Election. 


I. OFFICE:




ORDER

The Court relied on the arguments of Mr. Mayes and counsel as well as the underlying record of the Cherokee Nation Election Commission.


Therefore, the Court affirms the decision of the Cherokee Nation Election Commission.




